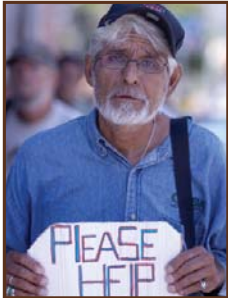




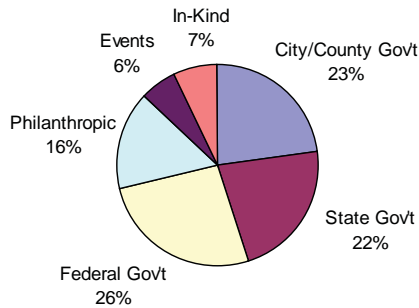

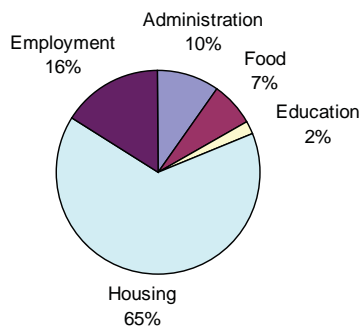

Founded in 1964, Caritas of Austin is a non-profit organization that serves 20,000 homeless, working poor and documented refugees in Travis County.

Mission. Caritas provides a service continuum for those experiencing poverty that begins with a safety net and links them to resources to achieve self-sufficiency.

Vision. Caritas envisions a community where there is respect for all individuals, hope for those experiencing poverty and opportunities for self-reliance.

Food. We will serve **100,000** meals in our community kitchen and provide enough take-home groceries for **70,500** meals.

Housing. We will prevent **2,000** men and women from becoming homeless. We will assist an additional **475** individuals and families access housing. Housing services range from one-time emergency rent and utility assistance to permanent supportive housing.

Education. We will provide **500** classes to **400** clients and provide refugee orientation to **460** refugees.

Employment. We will place **500** individuals in jobs. More than **50** local businesses will hire our clients.

Refugee Resettlement. Caritas assists documented refugees by providing and moving them into housing, acclimating them to their environment and helping them find employment.
